Aquariums – fresh water

You will need:

A PET bottle, water weed, sand, pebbles, fish, water, knife, scissors

Method:

- 1. With a marking pen draw lines along the sides and across the base and top of the PET bottle. Carefully cut across the base line with a serrated bread knife or sharp pointed blade. Cut along other lines with scissors.
- 2. Fill to just below the cut out section with water and place inside it elements such as water weed, sand and pebbles, plus the fish.
- 3. A support for the aquarium may be made from the bottom of another bottle. Cut a circle of paper the same diameter as the bottle, hold it against each side of the bottle near the bottom, draw around its outside with a marking pen and cut out the shape to fit the aquarium.
